### Description:

- Governmental primary school with 440 students and 15 teachers; 2 preschool classes, grade 1-5 each with 2 classes
- 2 English teachers (level A1 and level B2), several Non-English teachers (A1-B2)
- Poorly equipped with additional teaching material, small library

**Duration of the internship:** 3-6 months

**Tasks:** In-service teacher training for Lao English teachers in didactics, methodology and English language, development of teaching material, organizing workshops, reports for the project blog

**Requirements:** Language training especially for adults, patience and intercultural competences, creativity and team-work, e.g. for the further development of material

**Challenges:** Socialist Least Developed Country, English as a school subject only started 15 years ago, very low level of English throughout the country, lacks in school management (e.g. about holidays and teachers being absent)
